Greenville PD refuses to publicly reveal camera locations. SCDOT discovered 200+ unpermitted Flock cameras on SC roads in 2024. This request establishes the scope of surveillance in your area.

## TEMPLATE

Pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act (S.C. Code § 30-4-10 et seq.), I request copies of the following records:

1. The total number of automated license plate reader (ALPR) cameras currently operated by or on behalf of \_\_\_\_\_
2. The locations (street addresses or intersections) of all ALPR cameras operated by or on behalf of [AGENCY NAME]
3. Any permits obtained from SCDOT or other agencies for ALPR camera installation on public roadways
4. Any plans, proposals, or budget requests for expanding the ALPR camera network
5. Records of any cameras installed and subsequently removed, including the reason for removal

I request these records in electronic format where available. Per § 30-4-30(c), I ask that you notify me of any fees before processing.

## Filing Instructions

1. Fill in all bracketed fields with your information and the target agency.
2. Send via email, certified mail, or hand-deliver to the agency records custodian.
3. The agency has 15 business days to respond under SC FOIA (S.C. Code 30-4-30).
4. If denied, you may appeal to the circuit court within 15 business days.
5. Keep a copy of your request and any agency correspondence.
